## PACKING TIPS

- *Dress in layers: lightweight shirt, fleece or sweater, then a waterproof jacket.*
- *Expect temperatures from cool mornings to 60°F+ afternoons.*
- *Carry a backpack for extra layers, water, camera and souvenirs.*
- *Comfortable walking shoes are ideal; waterproof hiking shoes are great for active excursions.*
- *Jeans are fine, but remember cotton loses warmth when wet.*
- *Bring a rain jacket or poncho, especially for coastal ports.*
- *Pack binoculars for wildlife and glacier viewing.*
- *Check your cruise line's dress code before departure.*
